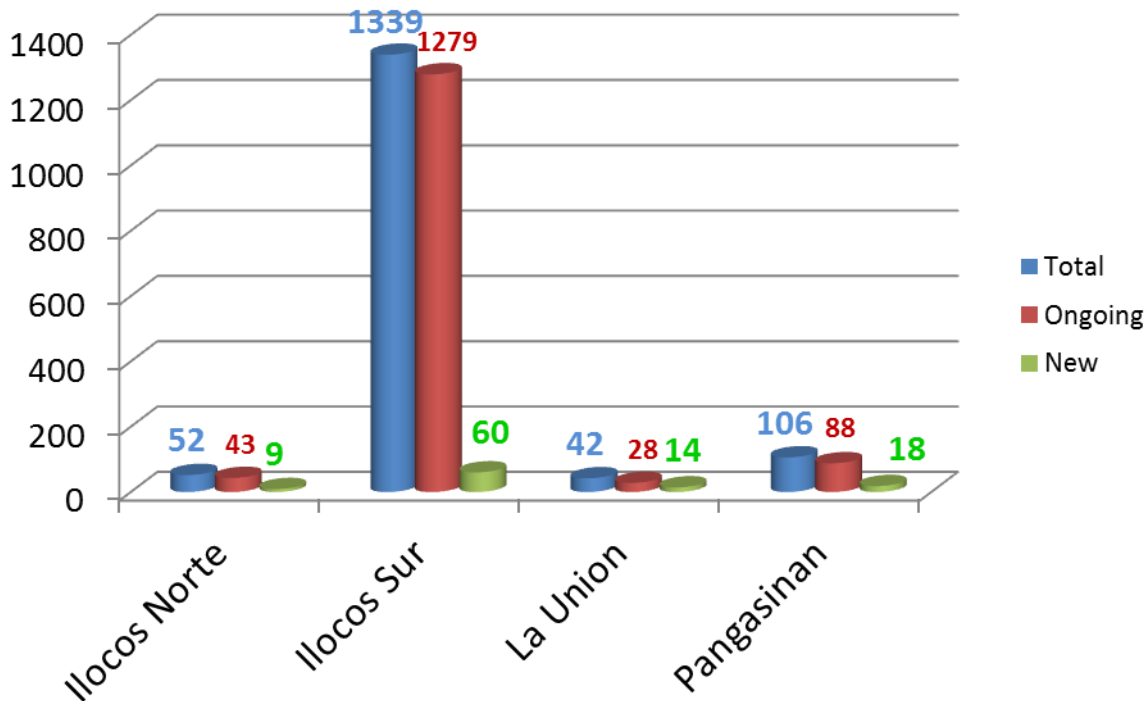

Total Ongoing Grantees: 1438 (89 grantees @ 20,000)

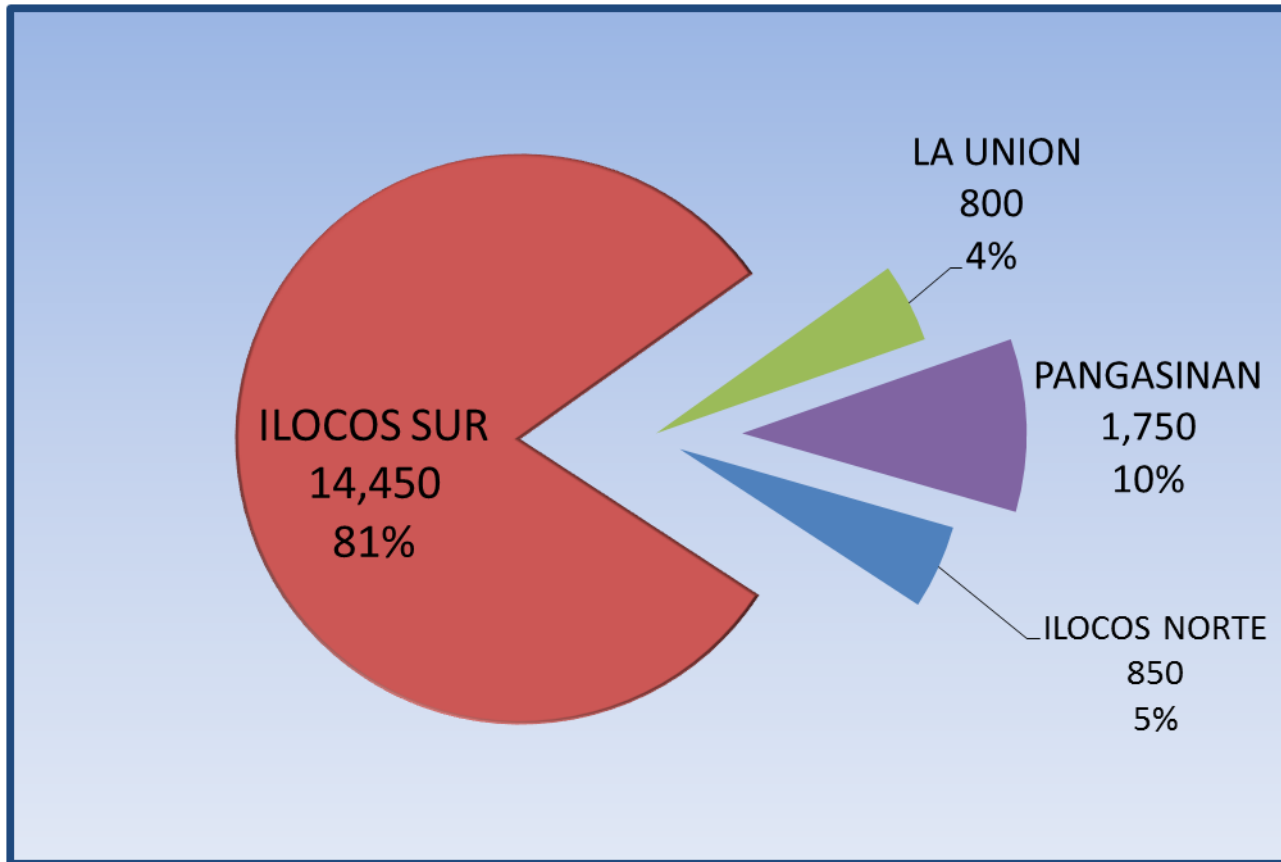
Total New Grantees: 101 (20,000)

-This current School Year, 94% (1438) of the total grantees are ongoing (enrolled in the 2nd to 4th year levels) and 7% (101) composed of the new grantees – enrolled as 1st year students.

-Of the 1539 total grantees, obviously, the province of Ilocos Sur shares more than 1/3 (87%, 1339) of the total grantees. The remaining 13% is thinly distributed to Pangasinan - 7% (106), Ilocos Norte – 3% (52), and La Union – 3% (42).

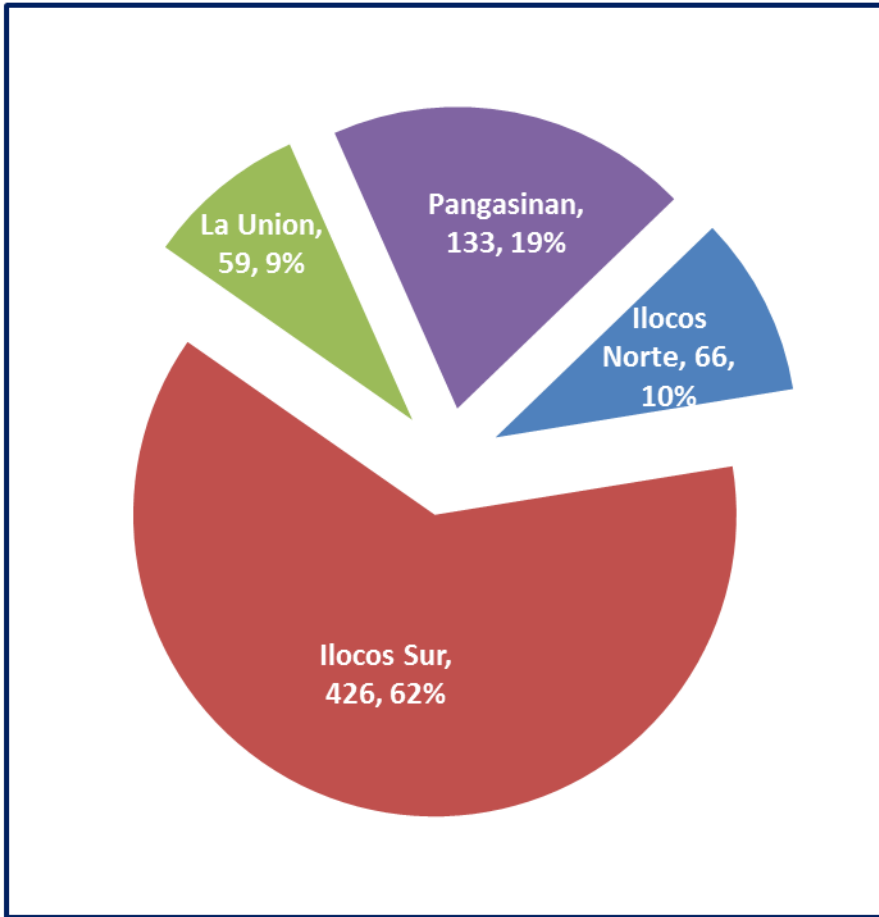
EAP ALLOCATION ('000) BY PROVINCE , SY 2014-2015

TOTAL BUDGET = 17750

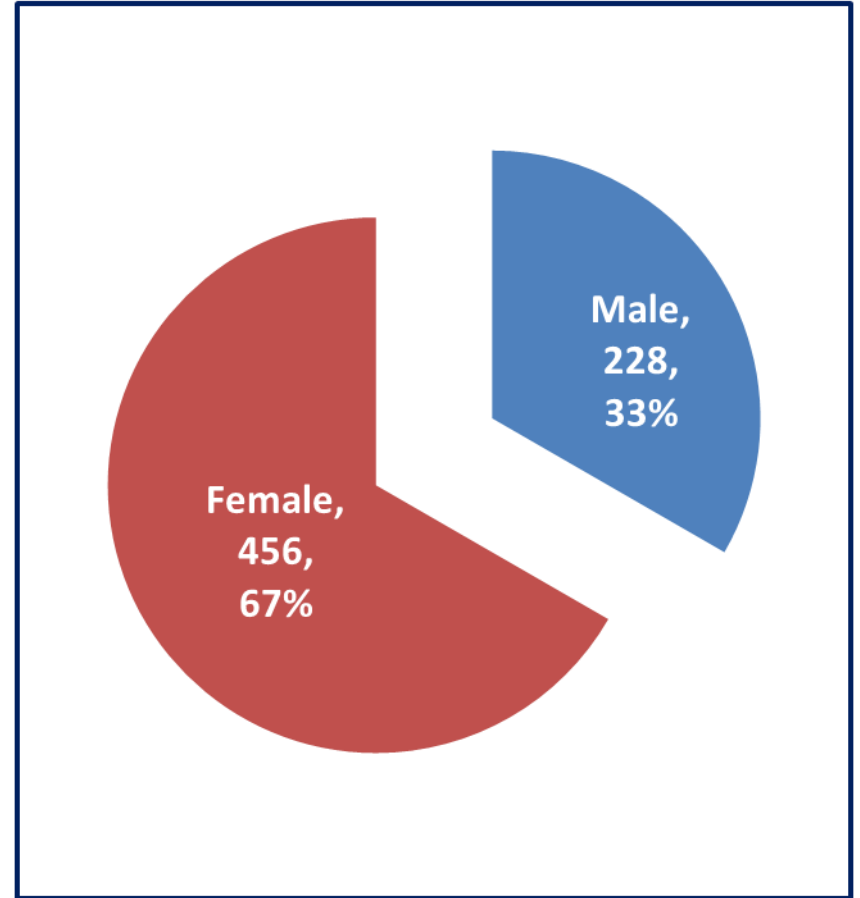


Province of Ilocos Sur has the largest share which is 81% and the Province of La Union has the smallest share which is 4%. The remaining 15% is shared by the provinces of Pangasinan and Ilocos Norte, with 10% and 5% respectively.

Distribution of Grantees By Province, SY 2013 – 2014

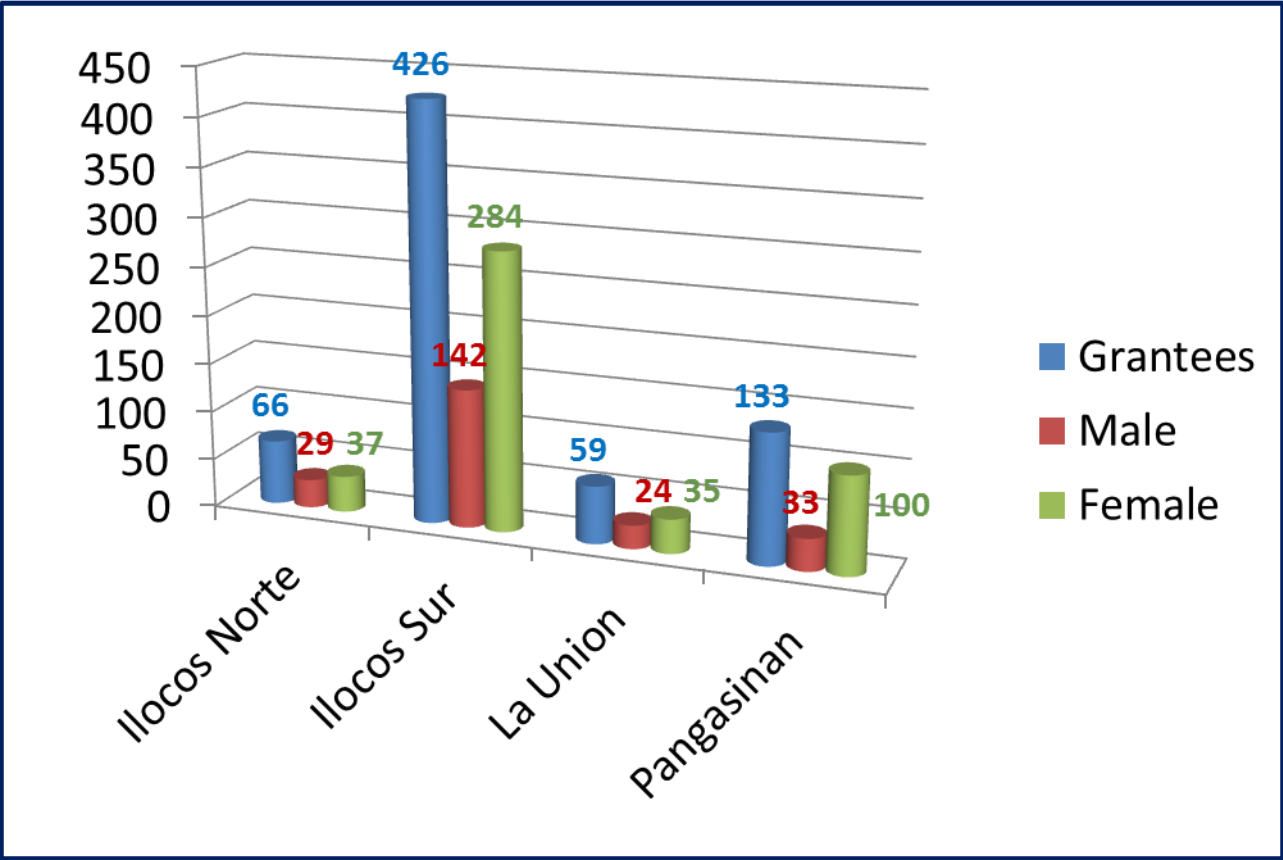


Distribution by Sex, SY 2013 – 2014



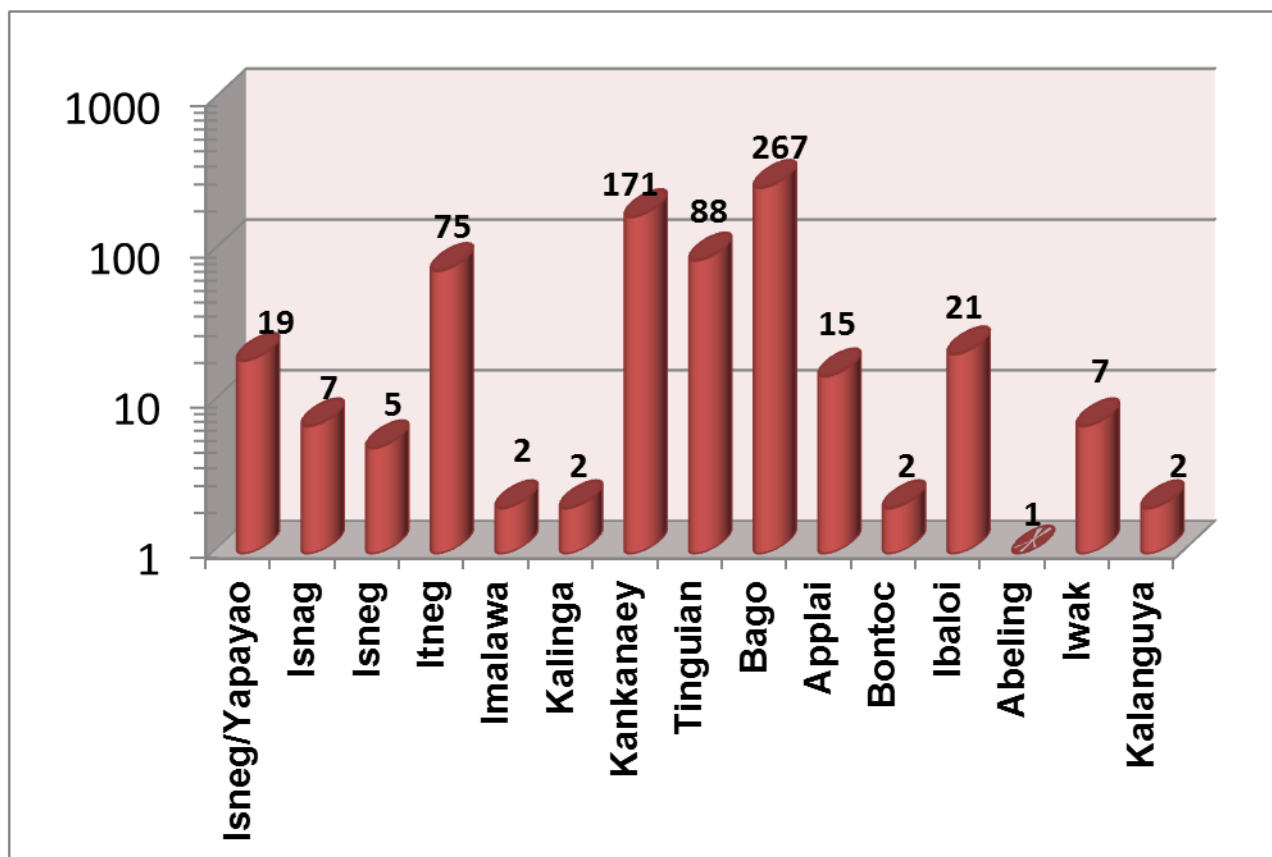

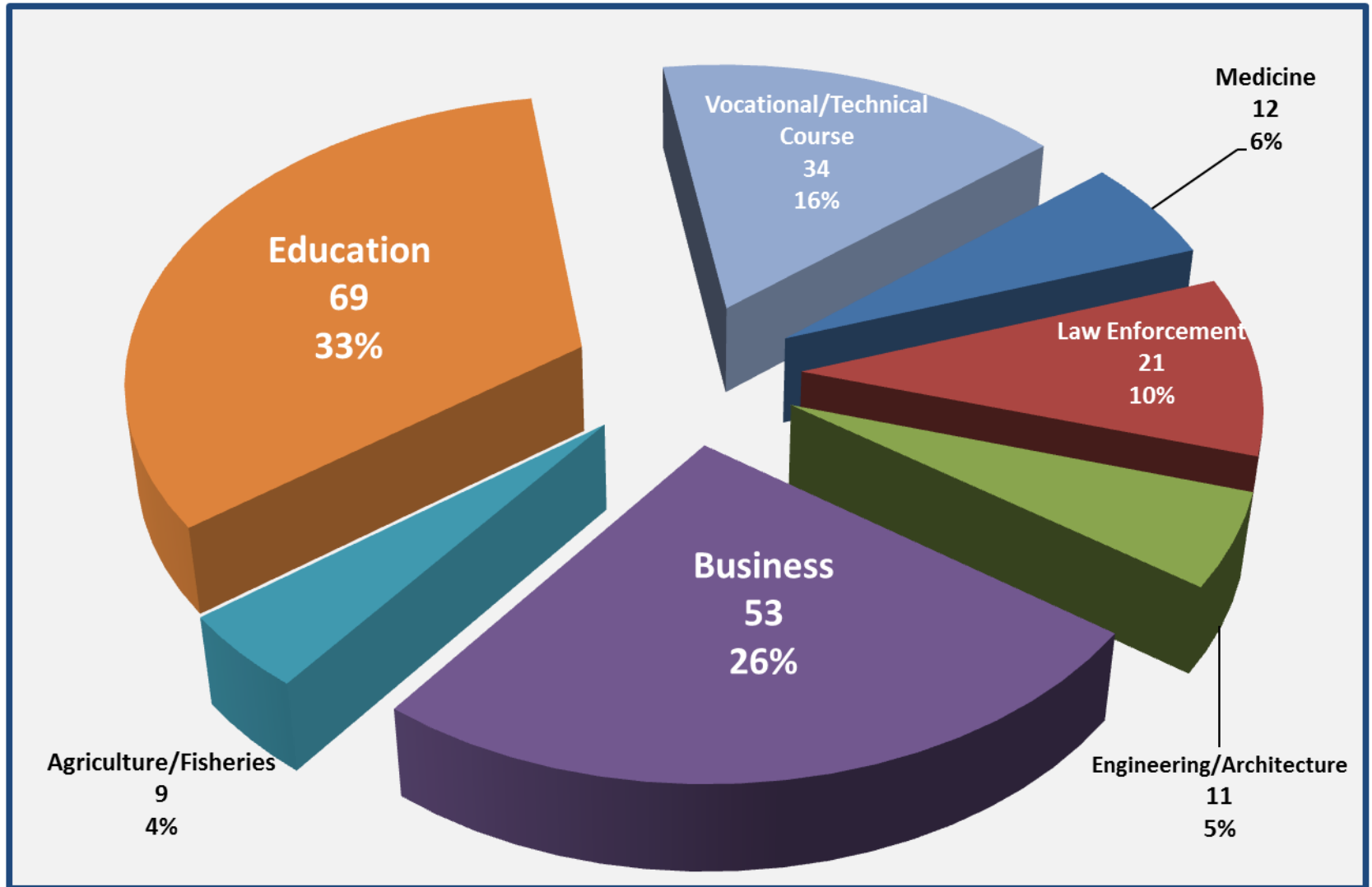
Distribution by Ethnolinguistic Group, SY 2013 – 2014

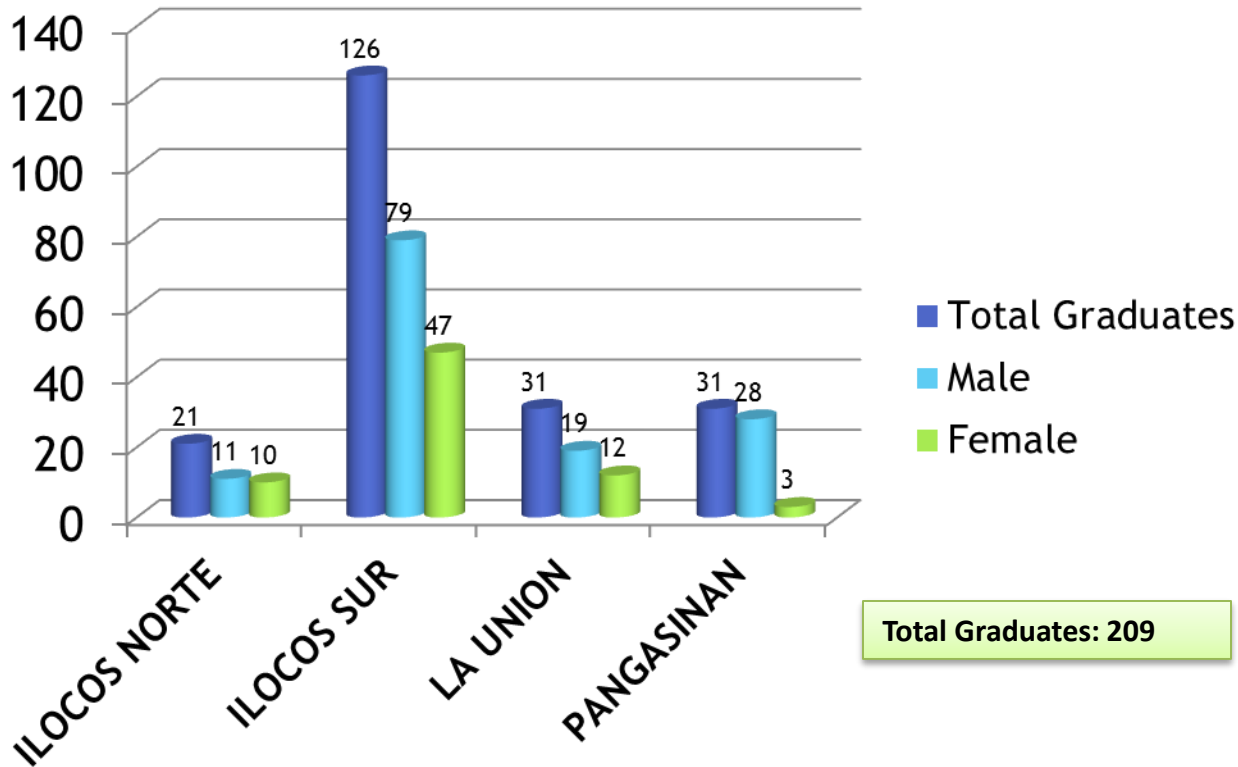
Distribution by Category / Course of Graduated Grantees, SY 2013 – 2014

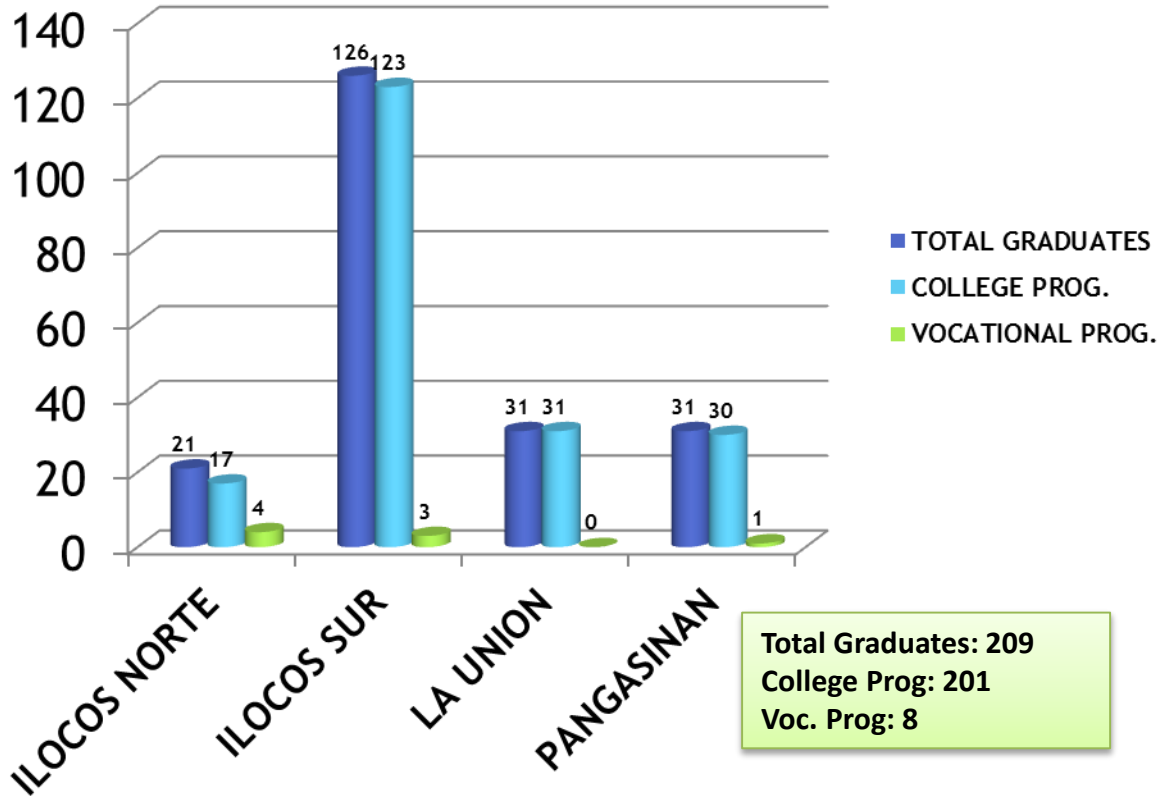
EAP GRADUATES BY SEX SY 2013-2014



- Of the **209 graduates** last SY, There are more female grantees who graduated consisting 66% (137) with that of the male grantees which is 34% (72).
- As gleaned from the chart, more than half of the graduates came from Ilocos Sur comprising 60% (126). The Provinces of La Union and Pangasinan have the same number of graduates covering 15% with 31 graduated grantees each and only 10% (21) graduates came from the Province of Ilocos Norte.

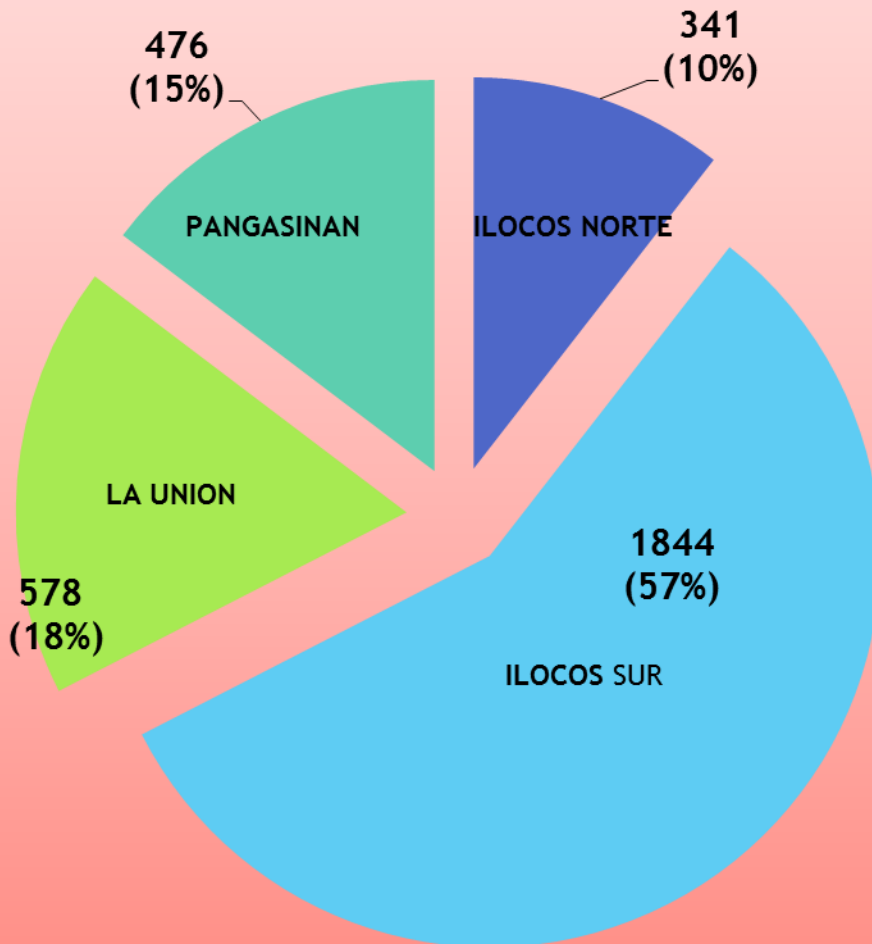
EAP GRADUATES BY EDUCATIONAL PROGRAM, SY 2013-2014



- Of the 209 graduates last SY, 96% (201 grantees) graduated in the degree program while only 4% (8 grantees) completed vocational program.
- Of the 8 graduated grantees of the vocational program, 4 are from Ilocos Norte, 3 are from Ilocos Sur, 1 is from Pangasinan and no graduates from La Union.
- It can be deduced then that IP students highly preferred baccalaureate than vocational courses.

SUMMARY OF EAP GRADUATES BY PROVINCE, SY 1998-1999 TO SY 2013-2014

- Within 16 School Years of EAP implementation, there are 3,239 students who graduated from the program.
- Of this total graduates, evidently the Province of Ilocos Sur got the highest percentage share which is nearly 60% comprising of 1,844 graduates.
- The remaining 40% of the graduates were thinly distributed from the 3 provinces, namely: La Union (18%); Pangasinan (15%); and Ilocos Norte (10%).
- Data on the number of graduates from the CEDSGG is not included in this presentation.

STATUS OF EAP GRADUATES

Of the 463 EAP graduates monitored in collaboration with the IP leaders/elders:

- ✓ 177 - employed in the government offices (teachers, police officer, medical staff)
- ✓ 41 – employed in the private institutions
- ✓ 5 - self-employed
- ✓ 120 - OFW
- ✓ 120 - unemployed
